

## **Basic Fiddle Chords**

- (A) G1/D1
- (B) G2/D2
- (C) G0/D1
- (D) G1/D2
- (E) D1/A1
- (F) *low*D2 *low*A2
- (G) G0/D0

## **Fiddle Capo Double Stops**

- I. Double 1<sup>st</sup> finger (key note & adjoining higher string)
- IV. 1<sup>st</sup> finger same + high 3<sup>rd</sup> finger on lower strong
- V. 1<sup>st</sup> finger same + 2<sup>nd</sup> finger on key note string

On G string – Key of A: IV Chord is 1<sup>st</sup> finger G1/D1 & 2<sup>nd</sup> finger D2. No need to go higher than A on G string for fiddle capo.

## **3-1 Finger Double Stop Option**

- I. 3<sup>rd</sup> (anchor) finger on key note + 1<sup>st</sup> finger on adjoining higher string
- IV. 3<sup>rd</sup> (anchor) finger on key note + 2<sup>nd</sup> low finger on adjoining higher string
- V. 3<sup>rd</sup> finger switch to higher adjoining string – 2<sup>nd</sup> finger switch to adjoining lower string (not low)
