### Recording Duets with Your Heroes

Matt, Justin, Megan, and Nate will each be recording with 4 or 5 campers – this is determined by a drawing that happens on the first day of camp. We post a list of the duet results and then it's up to you to connect with your instructor/duet partner to decide on a tune and get an arrangement together. There are two spots on the schedule just for this purpose. If you ask nicely, you might have the option of additional rhythm guitar, fiddle, or vocals on your recording. On the day of the recording, each instructor's duets will be grouped together and that group should head down to the den when it's time for them to record. Stay with your group so that we can make efficient use of the recording time. Kevin will be in charge of herding people in and out of the “studio” so just do what he says and no one gets hurt. Each duet will get two passes on their song so it will go rather quickly. Before and after your recording time, the other instructors will be leading jams, answering questions, and selling their incredible recordings and instructional materials up in the Great Room.
